Responsibilities:

- Collaborating with other faculty members to integrate learning and monitor homework load
- Mentoring students in discipleship
- Pursuing professional development to continually grow in the art of teaching

Duties:

Teaches to inspire students with the love of learning and teach them effectively, resulting in students that learn the logic and rhetoric skills of the content of the curriculum by:

- knowing the material that is being taught
- holding the interest of the students
- speaking in clear, vivid language
- meeting students' individual academic needs
- explaining unknown in terms of known
- challenging without exasperating students
- helping students to retain and apply knowledge
- planning and teaching lessons creatively
- creating home day lesson plans for students
- partnering with parents to receive tutoring services for students in need

Creates a classroom culture and trains students to be disciples of Jesus Christ by:

- demonstrating a love for the Gospel in personal life
- communicating God's truth in a winsome way
- creating a dominant tone of joy in all that God is and has done for us
- demonstrating love through the discipline policy
- having a studious classroom environment
- providing understandable standards for expected behavior
- maintaining standards of school culture



Demonstrates Christ-like behavior, attitude, and work ethic by:

- being punctual and prepared for student's arrival
- being responsible in all matters in the classroom as well as the school
- being a Christ-like example for the students
- following staff dress code
- following code of conduct
- submitting lesson plans on time
- returning graded assignments to students promptly
- maintaining an accurate online grade book
- communicating effectively with parents
- expecting excellence in all work, showing thoroughness, care, creativity, and neatness

Using effective classical teaching methodology by:

- Using analysis
- Being an excellent example of logic and rhetoric when lecturing
- guiding discussion and debate

Qualifications:

- possess a strong background in mathematics
- knowledgeable about classical Christian education preferred but not required
- continues to expand abilities by gaining further training
- bachelors degree preferred
