Duties/Responsibilities:

 - creating Friday home day lesson plans for students

 - communicating God's truth in a winsome way
 - creating a dominant tone of joy in all that God is and has done for us
 - demonstrating love through the discipline policy
 - having a studious classroom environment
 - providing understandable standards for expected behavior
 - maintaining standards of school culture
 - making sure students are in uniform

- Demonstrates Christ-like behavior, attitude, and work ethic by:
 - being punctual and prepared for students' arrival
 - being responsible in all matters in the classroom, as well as the school



- being a Christ-like example for the students
 - following the staff dress code
 - following the code of conduct
 - submitting lesson plans on time
 - returning assignments to students promptly
 - maintaining an accurate online grade book
 - communicating effectively with parents
 - expecting excellence in all work, showing thoroughness, care, creativity, and neatness
- Creating and maintaining a classroom environment that inspires learning by:
 - maintaining a neat and clean classroom
 - to reinforce an interest in curricular material creatively
 - Using effective classical teaching methodology by:
 - Using analysis
 - Being an excellent example of logic and rhetoric when lecturing
 - guiding discussion and debate
